Dear Tenant / User of the Anderson Municipal Airport;

I need your help! One of the most exasperating things I face as an airport manager is trying to talk to and have people understand the importance of aviation in our community as well as within the state of Indiana. There is a lack of understanding of the real benefits and the overall importance of aviation. If our legislators and the general public realized these benefits, we would have little, if any, difficulty getting infrastructure and other industry needs supported and funded.

Attached is a survey which has been developed jointly by three separate entities within the state, the Aviation Association of Indiana, Indiana Department of Transportation and Conexus that care about aviation and wish to calculate the overall economic benefit aviation has on the state. Your participation as a user of aviation and our airport is therefore being requested.

The form is very simple and should take no longer than a couple of minutes to fill out. I have included one with this letter. To be timely and beneficial, we need the information by the 15th of August. The survey can also be completed on line by going to www.aviationindiana.org. As an incentive for your participation, I will contact INDOT, to whom the survey is submitted, after the 15th of August and everyone who has filled out the form will get a \$5.00 credit on their next month's invoice. This will help you in a small way but will assist the industry in a large way to gather the information we require.

Please be assured that the information will be handled confidentially and will only be used to determine the overall economic impact of aviation within the state and for no other purposes. Should you have any questions or concerns please feel free to contact me.
